

A Guide for Funeral Arrangements

The funeral liturgy is an Easter liturgy. It finds all its meaning in the resurrection. Because Jesus was raised from the dead, we, too, shall be raised. The liturgy, therefore, is characterized by joy, in the certainty that "neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Usually, the family decides if the Eucharist will be celebrated, if family or friends will share remembrances, who the Layreader will be, and about flower arrangements or memorial gifts. However, you may want to provide some input regarding those matters.
